What College Students Should Know



What's the change?

Students enrolled at least half-time in undergraduate degree programs at public colleges and universities may now meet the CalFresh student exemption.



Does this apply to all students?

No. All college students are encouraged to apply to have CalFresh eligibility reviewed by the County.



What are other ways students may qualify?

Students may qualify if they:

- Work 20+ hours per week
- Participate in work study
- Care for a child under 6
- Meet another CalFresh student exemption



How can CalFresh help students?

CalFresh helps students buy healthy food and stretch their food budget while in school.
