Job Retention Services

Now that your CalWORKs case has closed...

You are eligible for up to 12 months of Job Retention Services

You will need to retain employment to remain eligible

You may continue to receive supportive services during this period

Child Care

Great news! Upon closure of your CalWORKs case, your child/ren will continue to be eligible for subsidized child care under Stage Two.

GoKids, Inc will manage your Stage 2 child care payments and ongoing eligibility.

There will be a seamless transition as the county transfers your child care to GoKids, Inc.

Stage 2 is limited to 24 months after your CalWORKs case closes.

- ▶ You may reach out to your ETS at any time during the 12-month period to check in or let us know if you need any additional resources from the County.

After 12 months, you may receive a \$500 cash payment if you are still employed and provide verification of employment.


