Support for Families Experiencing Homelessness

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If your family is currently experiencing homelessness, the County may be able to assist in the following ways:

- Temporary Homeless Assistance (THA): CalWORKs households that need nightly shelter may qualify for up to 16 days of THA in a 12-month period
- Storage Unit Assistance: Up to 12 months of assistance to cover the cost of a storage unit to store your belongings
- Referrals to Housing Assistance Programs

Families experiencing homelessness that find housing may be eligible for additional limited assistance:

- Security deposit
- Rental Support
- Furniture and Appliances

* This assistance is dependent upon availability of funding.

Family Stabilization Program

Ask us for a Family Stabilization referral if you or someone in your family experiences stress in any of the following areas:

- Mental or emotional health
- Substance abuse (alcohol or drugs)
- Domestic abuse
- Court-related matters
- Homelessness
- Physical health
- Child/Parenting



Once your CalWORKs case is approved, **full-time** child care is available for CalWORKs children through age 12.

Subsidized Employment Opportunities

We have paid employment programs that will help you build job skills, expand your resume and increase your work experience.

Goodwill

Subsidized Employment Program

- For participants with limited work experience
- Paid 16-week employment program in local Goodwill stores
- Completion Incentive = \$100

SmartHIRE

Subsidized Employment Program

- For participants with previous work experience
- Incentive of \$100 after 6-months of employment
