

IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA CRUZ-WATSONVILLE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Cruz County)

The unemployment rate in the Santa Cruz County was 8.5 percent in December 2020, up from a revised 6.8 percent in November 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 8.8 percent for California and 6.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
